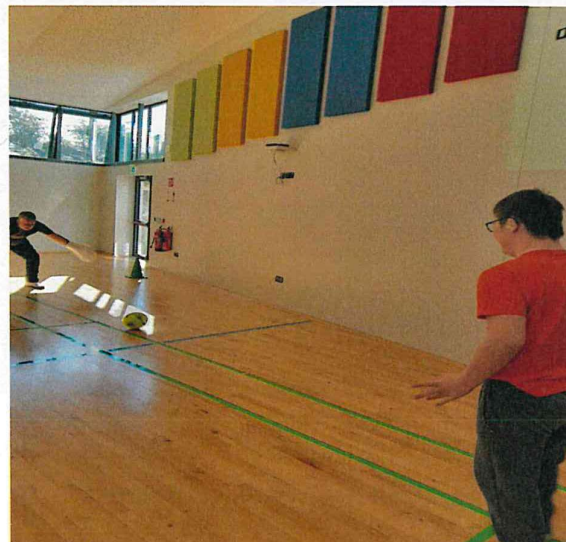
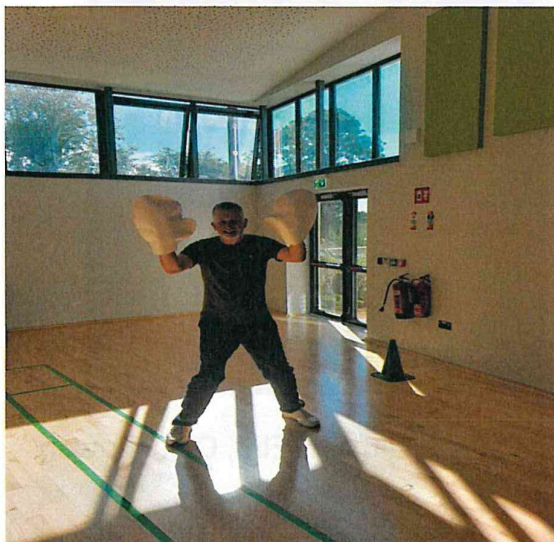


Welcome back. Here we are back in September starting a new year. A huge welcome must be put out to all our new students and staff.

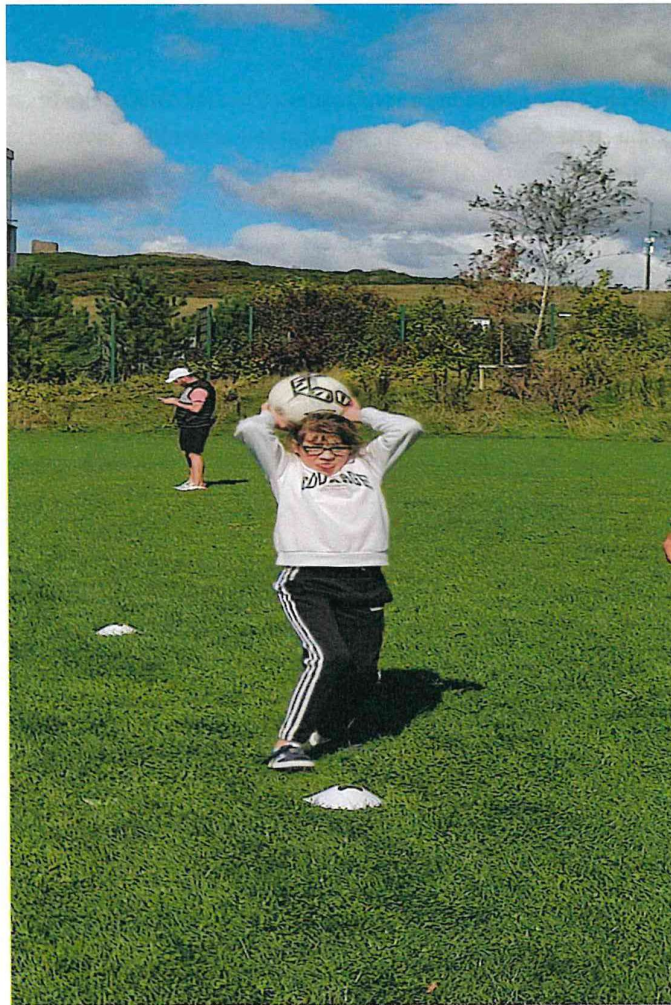
We would also like to welcome all the new staff who have joined us this year. Welcome to Amy, Ellie, Anna, Sarah, Emer, and Roisin.
