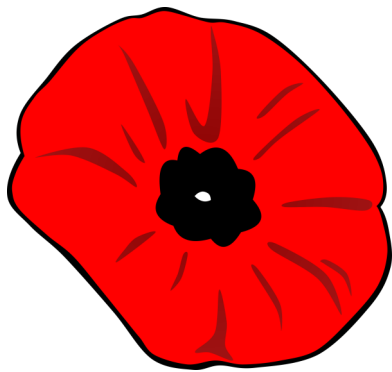


# February 2026

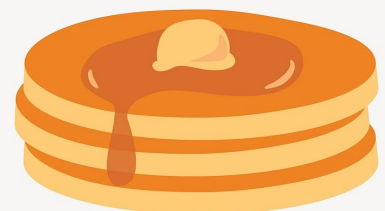
