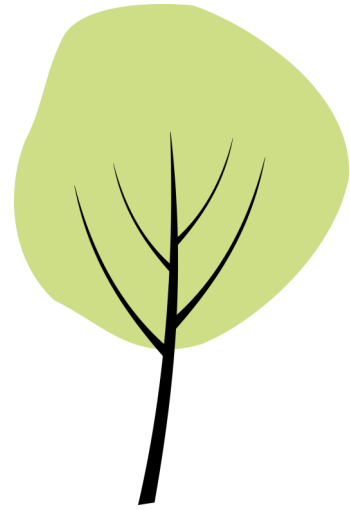


Class Oak
